July 2011 *******IMPORTANT! NOTE CHANGE OF LOCATION*******

Amador County Public Schools will charge fees for home-to-school transportation in the 2011–12 school year. The fee schedule is available on the district website under the transportation link or in the business office.

An Application for Home-to-School Transportation will be required and will include the option to apply for free or reduced fees in the case of financial hardship. Documentation verifying income **MUST** be provided. Eligibility will be determined based on the federal eligibility scale.

Students who will use school-provided transportation beginning the first day of school must have their fees paid and Application for Home-to-School Transportation submitted starting July 1, 2011 and no later than August 19, 2011. After the district provided grace period, students may not be allowed to use school-provided transportation until the fees are paid and the Application for Home-to-School Transportation is submitted, including the option to apply for free and reduced fees.

PAYMENTS

There are three ways you will be able to make your payment. Please note that *Drivers will not accept fee payments.*

- *1. Payments may be made in person at the **ACUSD TRANSPORTATION OFFICE**, located at **545 INDEPENDENCE DRIVE, SUTTER CREEK, CA 9-12am / 1-4 pm**
2. Payments may be mailed to: Amador County Unified School District Transportation, 545 Independence Drive, Sutter Creek, CA 95685 ATTN: Bus Fees.

SEMI-ANNUAL PAYMENTS – If you choose to make semi-annual payments, we will send a second payment notice in December/January. Payments must be received before January 6, 2011 or transportation will be denied.
