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To whom it may concern:

Deductibility:

Amador County Unified School District is a Local Education Agency (local government). Contributions made directly to this school district would be deductible under certain circumstances as described below. The Internal Revenue Code Section 170(c) states charitable contributions include contributions or gifts to or for the use of:

“A State, as possession of the United States, or any political subdivision of any of the foregoing, or the United States or the District of Columbia, but only if the contributions or gift is made exclusively for public purposes.”

Under Internal Revenue Code Section 103, a political subdivision is defined as:

“Any division of any state or local government unit which is a municipal corporation...”

Internal Revenue Service Form 1040 Schedule A instructions state that “you may deduct contributions or gifts you have gave to...Federal, state, and local governments if the first are solely of public purposes.” IRS publication 526 likewise states that contributions to local governments are deductible as charitable contributions when made solely for public purposes.

Contributions (cash, real, and/or personal property) are deductible if the contributor specifies that:

1. The contribution be used “for exclusively public purposes”
2. The donor does not receive any substantial benefit in return for the contribution.

The Internal Revenue Code may limit the percentage of charitable deductions allowed in certain circumstances. Please consult your tax advisor if you have additional questions.

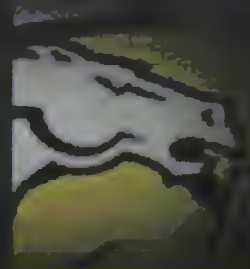

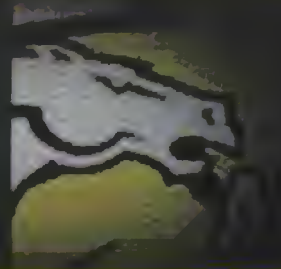

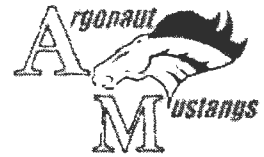
