The Six Dimensions of Board Competency

- **CONTEXTUAL:** The board's decision making is guided by a clear, shared understanding of the organization's mission, culture, and values.
- **EDUCATIONAL:** The board is well informed about the organization and about board member roles and responsibilities.
- **INTERPERSONAL:** The board functions well as a cohesive group and manages conflict appropriately.
- **ANALYTICAL:** The board examines all sides of issues and engages effectively in problem solving.
- **POLITICAL:** The board takes the necessary steps to build and maintain good relationships with all organization stakeholders.
- **STRATEGIC:** The board focuses most of its attention on issues and priorities that are vital to enhancing the organization's future.
