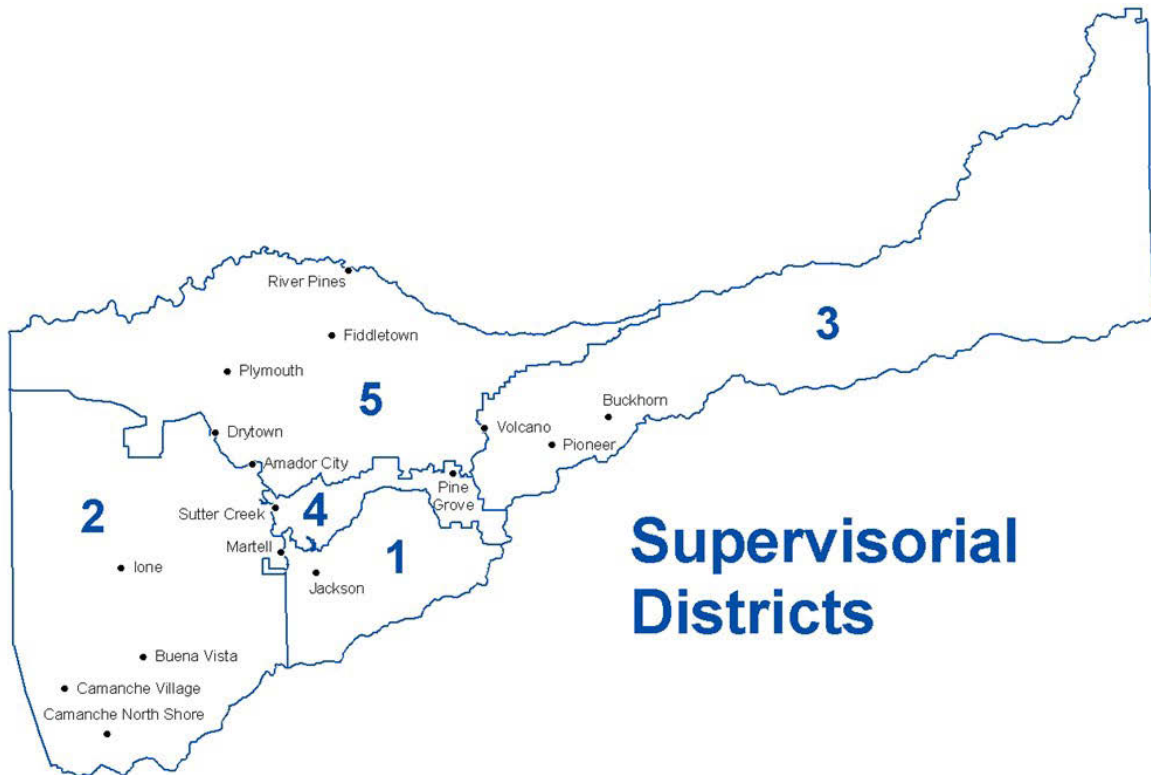


Ione Community Meeting Follow-up Survey for Stakeholder Feedback April 15, 2019
