

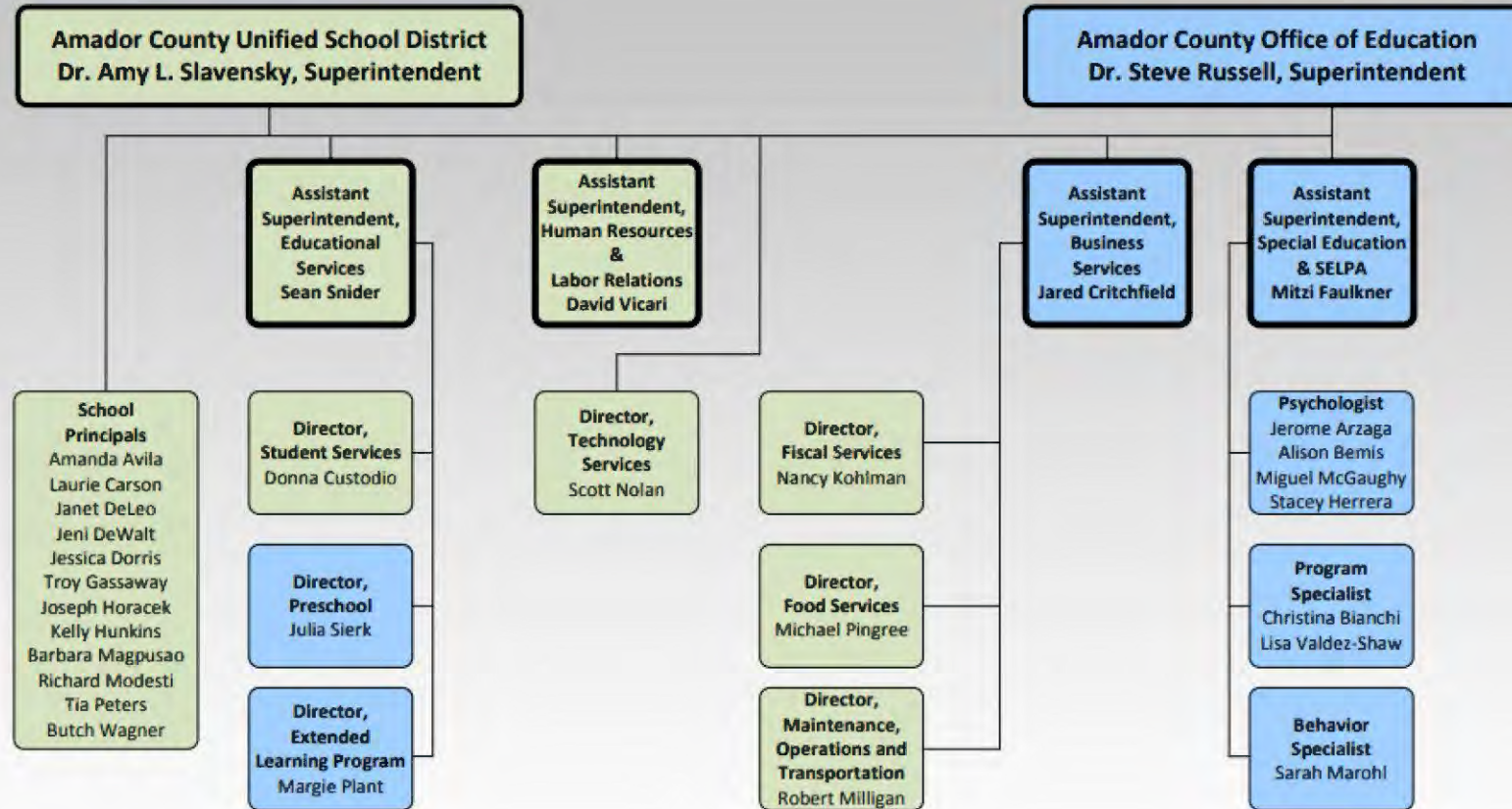
Purpose of the MOU – The Why
